

“Sensoriality” Photo Contest Rules

Terms and Conditions

SFAS (Société Française d'Analyse Sensorielle) organizes a photo contest during the 14th Pangborn Symposium hold in Nantes from the 20th to the 24th August 2023.

The contest is open to all participants of the 14th Pangborn Symposium 2023. Only submissions from Amateur Photographers from all over the world will be considered. Anyone over the age of 18 can participate in the contest with a commitment to register for the symposium. Only participants on the final list of registrants to the 14th Pangborn Symposium will be eligible to receive a prize.

By sending your photography to the SFAS you hereby accept these Terms and Conditions. By entering the Contest, you agree and acknowledge that the SFAS is permitted to receive your registration data.

SFAS may publish any material you submit, post, upload, email or otherwise transmit to it or to the website in its sole discretion and it shall be entitled to make additions or deletions to any such material prior to publication.

Any image submitted to the contest may be used by SFAS for marketing and promotional purposes of its events. You hereby grant to the SFAS, a non-exclusive, irrevocable license to each Entry throughout the world in all media for any use.

Winners will be announced during the Pangborn symposium 2023 in Nantes and will be published online on <https://sfasenso.fr/>. Any image submitted to the contest may be used by SFAS during the 14th Pangborn Symposium.

The maximum number of photos per participant is 3. Contest entry is free by providing your registration to 14th Pangborn Symposium 2023. Files must meet the following specifications:

- sRGB or Adobe98 colour space, 8-bit;
- Longest dimension must be 1100 pixels;
- Saved as a JPEG at a setting of 10 (100%) or higher.
- No Watermarks / Copyright Units / Logos on images
- Only bleed photographs without borders

- Name your pictures with your surname, name, followed by the numbers 1, 2 and/or 3.

Winning Entrants must be able to provide a high resolution digital file. This file will be used only to prove the ownership of the image. Winning Entrants who do not fulfill these eligibility criteria will be deemed ineligible and disqualified without the right to appeal.

Images that have won prizes in other competitions or that have been submitted in other competitions currently underway are eligible.

There is no time or date restriction on when the image was taken.

All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrant must be the sole copyright owner of all photographs entered and must have obtained permission of any people featured in the entries (or their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured). Further, the entrant must not have breached any laws when taking the photographs.

Copyrights & usage rights

Copyright of the images will remain at all times with the photographer.

For TOP 20 selected images, copyright holders grant to the SFAS unlimited non-exclusive use of high-resolution images for activities in all media, including social media, online and print, in relation to the contest and all promotional activities of SFAS without any remuneration being due.

Copyright holders of all submitted images grant to the SFAS non-exclusive use of low-resolution pictures on our website, without any remuneration being due.

Images will be used strictly in connection to the awards and will not be used for any other marketing purposes other than to promote the SFAS and during its events. Images will not be resold or used for commercial purposes by any other third party.

To promote winners of the contest, it is granted the right to display images on social network websites (on our official profiles) including : LinkedIn, Facebook and Instagram.

You agree to participate in related publicity and to the use of your name and images for the purposes of advertising, promotion and publicity in connection with the contest without additional compensation.

SFAS assumes no responsibility and it is not liable for any image misuse by external third parties.

Any photograph used by the SFAS shall carry a credit line.

Prizes

Prizes will be French Gourmet Boxes, which will be delivered at the awards ceremony at the end of the 14th Pangborn Symposium or by plane if the winner is not present in Nantes at the congress.

The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered.

Judging conditions

Nominations will be judged by 5 judges nominated by the SFAS President or his representative. The jury will be chaired by the president of the SFAS or his representative.

The jury members cannot submit a photo for the contest.

20 images will be preselected by the jury from all submitted photos. These 20 photos will be exhibited during the 14th Pangborn Symposium. The public present in Nantes will vote anonymously.

The 3 winners (Golden Star, Silver Star and Bronze Star award) will be chosen based on the highest individual score. In the case of exaequo, the individual ratings of the preselection jury will be used.

The counting of votes will be coordinated by the SFAS President or his representative. Only the SFAS President or his representative will be in charge of the final decision. The decision of the SFAS is definitive.
